- Now through Thursday, Sept. 10- Preparation - 9:00 – 12:00 am Unpack and sort, arrange tables, and mark items that are specially priced. Sit-down jobs are available.
- Friday, September 11 - Members' and Public Sales – Tally and bag sales. Keep tables full and neat and straighten up after 4:00 pm.
- Saturday, September 12 – BOOK SALE - 9:00 am – 5:00 pm Distribute shopping bags, tally and bag sales and keep tables full and neat.
- Sunday, September 13 - Clearance Sale - 1:30 - 4:00 pm Explain how the sale works and keep tables as neat as possible.
- Monday, September 14 - Cleanup – 9:00am Pack up remaining items, collect odds and ends that must be stored for next year and generally restore order to the community room.

FOSL Helps Start New Library Program

This past spring the FOSL group donated funds to initiate a Spring Reading Program for Adults. The program ran from March 1st – May 15th, 2009. The Spring Reading Program for Adults consisted of 78 participants ages 18 and above who were encouraged to read or listen to 3 books and then fill out an entry form that was entered into weekly drawings for prizes. The final entries show that 281 books were read or listened to by the participants. Library staff determined this start up program was a terrific success in connecting readers with books and community outreach.

The library staff held ten weekly drawings during March, April, and May. Each week a uniquely themed prize was awarded to the chosen patron. The themes included A Night In, Coffee Lover's Delight, Love My Car, Salem is the Best, Beach Escape, A Health Me, Picnic Fun, Mystery, Sport's Fan, and Pamper Yourself. Each weekly winner received his or her prize in a library tote bag, which was funded by the FOSL contribution to the program. These funds also helped purchase prize items that were not donated by library staff or by the community.
